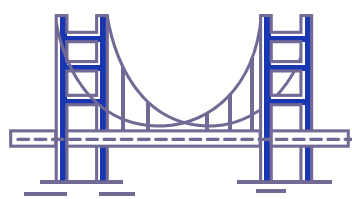

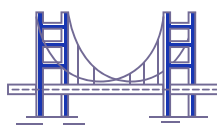

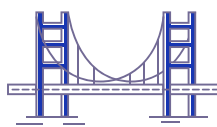
Dhanasree Jayaram

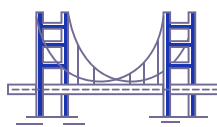
Harsh Pant

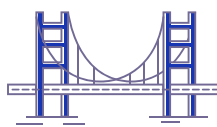
M D Nalapat

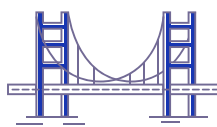
Priya Vijaykumar Poojary
